



Waitaki Summer Music Camp

7 – 17 January 2016

Play wonderful chamber and orchestral music in a friendly, encouraging, holiday atmosphere guided by excellent tutors, and enjoy the delights of Oamaru. This camp suits musicians of all ages and a wide range of abilities (from grade six level upwards), including families.

You can choose to attend only the **chamber music programme (7-10 January)** or the **orchestral programme (11-17 January)** or both.

The camp is held at Waitaki Boys' High School and most participants live on site. There are lots of opportunities for socialising - getting to meet new people and catching up with friends from previous camps.

Participants in the chamber music programme are each placed into at least two groups and encouraged to perform to each other in informal concerts. Pre-formed groups can also be accommodated. Players will be sent the music in advance, once enrolments are confirmed and groups arranged. Any requests for specific pieces of music will be considered.

The orchestral programme consists of a full orchestra, string orchestra and concert band, and concludes with a public concert on the evening of Saturday 16 January, followed by a fun concert for camp participants only.

Music for the orchestral programme is:

- Walton – Spitfire Prelude and Fugue**
- Delius – The Walk to the Paradise Garden**
- Elgar – Romance for Bassoon and Orchestra (with soloist Rebecca Brimble)**
- Schubert – Symphony no 8 in B min (“Unfinished symphony”)**
- Mozart – Divertimento in D K136 (String orchestra)**
- Vaughan Williams – English Folk Song Suite (Concert band)**
